National University of Athens, School of Chemical Engineering (NTUA) Students Explore VR Learning with HECOF

In December 2024, NTUA students participated in the first evaluation of the HECOF VR learning system, experiencing immersive simulated lab experiments focused on extracting bioactive materials from olive leaves. Adaptemy played a key role in personalizing the learning process, ensuring a smooth transition from virtual practice to real lab work.

POLIMI Students Test HECOF VR Learning System




Human-Centric Technologies and Applications for the Future of Extended Reality
